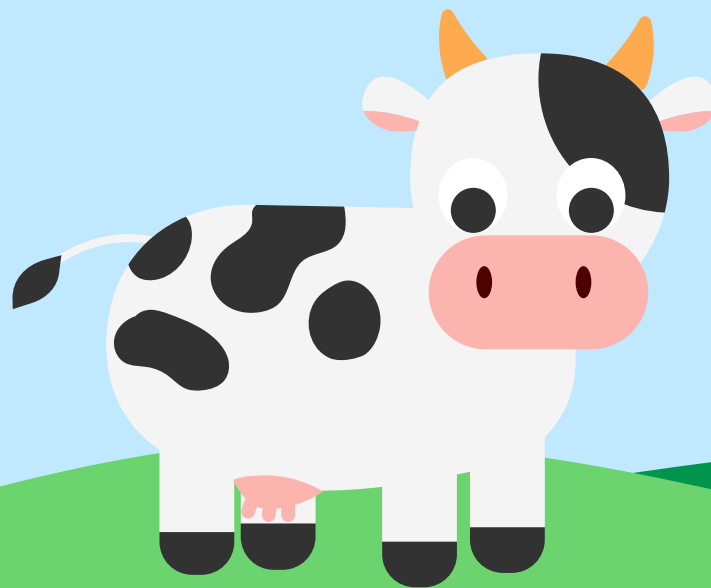

## So, why do we need to raise funds?

Compassion Acts is a charity organisation that receives no government funding, which means we rely on public donations to fund our services.

- Compassion Acts run 6 local Foodbanks in the Southport & Formby area, along with 5 Food Pantries - our monthly food club membership.
- Our Welfare Benefit advisors offer free advice and support for people in the community struggling with the benefit system or debt management.
- We offer a Uniform Hub to parents who need extra help with the cost of Uniforms, to hopefully ease the financial burden.
- We also provide social wellbeing support including free courses, cooking classes, family activities, warm spaces and more.

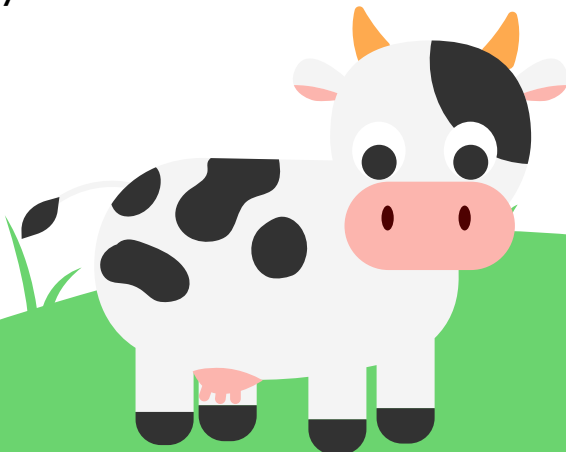
## Overview
